ORDER

Whereas for peaceful observance in connection with the “Rath-Yatra” festival to be celebrated on 07.07.2024 and Purnar-Yatra (Ultra-Rath) on 15.07.2024 & 16.07.2024 throughout the Howrah Police Commissionerate area, it is necessary in the interest of Public safety and also to prevent danger, obstruction, inconvenience to Public in general during the Procession, to impose traffic restrictions for regulating the movement of vehicles at different parts of Howrah Commissionerate during the period. In exercise of powers conferred upon me U/S 112(2)/115/116/117 of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 vide notification no. 2827(A)-WT/3M-80/2002 dated 01.09.2011 of Transport Department, I, Praveen Kumar Tripathi, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Howrah do hereby issue the following restriction orders as per the following time-schedules on the following roads-

Restrictions for All types of Goods Vehicles:

Movement of all types of Goods Vehicles (Except vehicles carrying LPG Cylinders only, Petroleum, Oil, Lubricants & Oxygen, Vegetable, Medicine, Fruits, Fish & Milk carrying vehicles) will be restricted from 13:00 hrs to 22:00 hrs on 07.07.2024 and from 13:00 hrs to 22:00 hrs on 15.07.2024 & 16.07.2024 on the following roads:

1. No Goods vehicles will be allowed to move towards Ranihati along NH-16 from Kona morh.
2. No Goods vehicles coming from Kolkata side will be allowed to move towards Ranihati crossing along NH-16 from Nibra.
3. No Goods vehicles will be allowed to move towards Ranihati crossing along NH-16 from Alampur crossing.
4. No Goods vehicles will be allowed to move towards Ranihati crossing along NH-16 from Dhulagarh crossing.
5. No Goods vehicles should be allowed to move towards Ranihati crossing along NH-16 from Panchla side.
6. No Goods vehicles should be allowed to move towards Ranihati crossing from Maitypara along NH-16.
7. No Goods vehicles should be allowed to move towards Ranihati crossing along NH-16 from Nivedita Toll or Bally side.
8. No Goods Vehicles should be allowed to move in Howrah City area.

THE ABOVE REGULATION SHALL BE ENFORCED IN ADDITION TO THE NORMAL RESTRICTIONS ON THOSE DAYS, WHICH ARE NOT REPUGNANT TO THE ABOVE.
