Whereas it is necessary for the interest of public safety and convenience in connection with **Annual URS Ceremony**, **2024** to be celebrated **from 18:30 hrs. on 01.12.2024 to 06:00 hrs. on 02.12.2024 (next day)** it is informed by Kolkata Police vide Traffic Notification No TP/52 dated 27.11.2024 of Commissioner of Police, Kolkata & Memo No TCR/440/2024 dated 28.11.2024 of DCP Traffic Kolkata that on that particular days all types of Goods Vehicles will be allowed to enter into the jurisdiction of Kolkata Police in and around Hastings area and through 2nd Hooghly Bridge (Vidyasagar Setu). In exercise of powers conferred upon me U/S 112(2)/115/116/117 of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 vide notification no. 2827(A)-WT/3M-80/2002 dated 01.09.2011 of Transport Department. I, Shri Praveen Kumar Tripathi, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Howrah do hereby issue the following restriction orders as per the following time-schedule on the following roads —

Restrictions for Goods Vehicles:

Exceptions:-

Emergency vehicles like – LPG vehicles, Milk Van, Oxygen, Medicine, Vegetable or fruits carrying Goods Vehicles, etc.

Movement of Goods Vehicles will be restricted from 18:30 hrs on 01.12.2024 to 06:00 hrs on 02.12.2024 (next day) in following roads-

- All kinds of Goods Vehicles will be restricted at No entry point at Alampur under fly over towards 2nd Hooghly Bridge.
- 2. Kazipara Crossing towards Kolkata via 2nd Hooghly Bridge.
- 3. Hang-Sung Crossing towards Drainage Canal Road & 2nd Hooghly Bridge.
- 4. Kona Truck terminal towards Kolkata & Howrah City along Kona Expressway & 2nd Hooghly Bridge.
- 5. Near Nibra More towards Kolkata & Howrah City along Kona Expressway & 2nd Hooghly Bridge.
- 6. Near Mourigram more towards 2nd Hooghly Bridge along Andul Road.
- Ramp of 2nd Hooghly Bridge towards Mandirtala.
- 8. T.C. Motor near Salap More towards Kolkata via 2nd Hooghly Bridge.

These regulations will remain in force in addition to the other normal traffic restrictions on the days, which are not repugnant to the above.

NB: Goods Vehicles may also be diverted from any of the roads by the Traffic Police on duty as and when considered necessary.
