Whereas it is necessary for preventing danger, obstruction or inconvenience to the public to regulate traffic of all kinds during the **Chhat Puja festival on 19.11.2023 and 20.11.2023**, I, Praveen Kumar Tripathi, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Howrah in exercise of the powers conferred upon me U/S 112(2)/115/116/117 of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 vide notification no. 2827(A)-WT/3M-80/2002 dated 01.09.2011 of Transport Department do hereby issue the following restriction orders as per following time schedule on the following roads -

(I) In the interest of public safety and convenience the movement of Goods Vehicles shall be prohibited to ply towards Kolkata as well as within Howrah City as per the following schedule on the following roads –

From 11:30 hrs. to 22:00 hrs. on 19.11.2023. From 02:30 hrs. to 10:00 hrs. on 20.11.2023.

#### Exceptions:-

- Emergency vehicles like Vehicles carrying LPG Cylinders only, Petroleum, Oil, Lubricants, Oxygen, Milk, Medicine, Vegetable / Fruits / Fish etc.
  - 1. Nimtala crossing towards Bally along GT Road.

- 2. Ballykhal Island towards Bally along GT Road.
- 3. Maitypara crossing towards Gurudwara / Nibedita Setu / Bally.
- 4. NH2 & NH6 crossing towards Nibedita Setu.
- 5. 'O' point towards Old Bally Bridge / Nibedita Setu.
- Bamundanga Island towards Bally & Dakshineswar along GT Road & Vivekananda Setu.
- 7. All kinds of goods vehicles restriction / diversion on NS Road approaching towards Liluah Flyover from Liluah side & Bally side.
- 8. Near Salap Morh towards Dasnagar along Howrah Amta Road.
- 9. Near Salap bazaar towards Dasnagar along Howrah Amta Road.
- 10. No entry has been imposed at Belgachia Morh on Benaras Road. Any Goods vehicles if comes from Dankuni side will be diverted again towards Dankuni from this point.
- 11. Kona Morh on NH6 towards Liluah along Benaras Road.
- 12. Kazipara Crossing towards Kolkata & towards Howrah via 2<sup>nd</sup> Hooghly Bridge & GT Road.
- 13. Coal depot towards Howrah along Foreshore Road.
- 14. Tollplaza towards Kolkata via 2<sup>nd</sup> Hooghly Bridge and Kazipara.
- 15. Ramp of 2<sup>nd</sup> Hooghly Bridge towards Mandirtala and Kazipara.
- 16. Near Alampur Morh towards 2<sup>nd</sup> Hooghly Bridge along Andul Road.
- Hung-Sung crossing towards Drainage Canal Road & 2<sup>nd</sup> Hooghly Bridge.
- 18. Kona Truck terminal towards Kolkata & Howrah City along Kona Expressway & 2<sup>nd</sup> Hooghly Bridge.
- 19. Near Nibra Morh towards Kolkata & Howrah City along Kona Expressway & 2<sup>nd</sup> Hooghly Bridge.
- All kinds of goods vehicles will be restricted within Bally & Howrah Municipal area as per time format mentioned above.

(II) In the interest of public safety and convenience the movement of all vehicles shall be prohibited to ply within the Howrah Police Commissionerate area as follows:-

From 11:30 hrs. to 22:00 hrs. on 19.11.2023. From 02:30 hrs. to 10:00 hrs. on 20.11.2023.

#### Exceptions:-

- Emergency vehicles like Vehicles carrying LPG Cylinders only, Petroleum, Oil, Lubricants, Oxygen, Milk, Medicine, Vegetable / Fruits / Fish etc.
  - All type of vehicles entry and parking From Banstala Ghat to Rail Museum on Grand Foreshore road.
  - 2. Goods vehicle Entry & Parking within HRS TG area during Chhat
  - No vehicle will proceed towards Rail Museum & Burn More from Station area.

- From Fazir Bazar Crossing towards Banstala Ghat Crossing along Gangadhar Mukherjee Lane.
- All type of vehicles entry and parking from Coal Depot to towards, Shibpur burning Ghat and river side road up to Shibpur launch Ghat road and Foreshore road crossing.
- (III) The vehicular traffic shall be diverted to ply within the Howrah Police Commissionerate area as specified below at the following roads -

From 11:30 hrs. to 22:00 hrs. on 19.11.2023. From 02:30 hrs. to 10:00 hrs. on 20.11.2023.

- 1. Maitypara Crossing from Delhi Road (NH 2) towards Mumbai Road side and vice - versa.
- 2. Belgachia morh towards Kona morh along Benaras Road.
- 3. A Road under Liluah PS towards Belgachia Kona morh.
- 4. Merging point of Andul Road ramp and Kona Expressway ramp on 2<sup>nd</sup> Hooghly Bridge towards Kona Expressway.
- 5. Kazipara Crossing towards Bangabashi along GT Road.
- 6. Banstala Ghat Crossing towards Coal Depot & Kazipara along Foreshore Road & J B Ghat Road.
- 7. Fazir Bazar Crossing towards Bangabashi along GT Road.
- 8. All long distance buses will ply along Panchanantala Road instead of Fore Shore Road.
- 9. All type of passenger vehicles Proceed towards North (Burn More/ Rail Station) via Kazi Para will avail GT Road instead of Fore Shore Road.
- (IV) THE ABOVE REGULATION SHALL BE ENFORCED IN ADDITION TO THE NORMAL RESTRICTIONS WHICH ARE NOT REPUGNANT TO THE ABOVE.

#### **ORDER**

Memo No. 1342(60)/CP

WHEREAS, a large number of commercial places, network service providers and shops have come up in the Metropolitan area of Howrah as notified in this behalf, in the popular name Cyber Cafe,

AND WHEREAS, a large number of people frequently visit these Cafes to use the internet, computer network facilities available in those cyber cafes,

AND WHEREAS, there is every likelihood that the said facilities might be used by persons knowingly or intentionally to mislead the security and investigating agencies, commit offence as defined in Chapter-XI of the Information Technology Act, 2000 (21 of 2000), create panic in the public, help in anti-national activities affecting security of

AND WHEREAS, it is felt expedient to cause immediate prevention of those apprehended danger and arrange for speedy remedy thereof, in the interest of public tranquility, safety of human life, prevention of injury, annoyance to persons etc.,

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the power conferred by subsection (I) read with sub-section (3) of section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (2 of 1974), I, Praveen Kumar Tripathi, Commissioner of Police, Howrah and Executive Magistrate in relation to the Metropolitan area of Howrah and being empowered so to do by the State Government Home (Police) Department Order No. 3636-PL/PB/14M-138/04 dt. 26.08.2011 to act under Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (2 of 1974), do hereby order, the owners of the said cyber cafes and persons having management of those cyber cafes to follow the followings in respect of those cyber cafes, viz. :-

- Prohibiting the use of cyber cafe by unknown person and whose identity has not been established before the owner of the cafe.
- Maintaining a register for identity of the visitors or users. b)
- Make an entry in the handwriting of the visitors or users maintaining name, address, telephone number and identity proof. The visitors/users shall also sign the register kept for this purpose.
- The identity of the visitors or users shall be established through Identity Card, Voter Card, Ration Card, Driving License, Passport and Photo Credit Card (any one of them).
- Activity server log should be preserved in main server and its record should be preserved for at least six months from the point of last use.
- If any activity of any visitors or users is of a suspicious nature, the owner of Cyber Cafe shall immediately inform the nearest Police Station.
- Record be maintained about the specific computer used by the visitor or user.

This order shall come into force on and from 26th day of November, 2023 and remain in force for a period of 60 (sixty) days i.e., upto 24<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2024 unless rescinded or altered earlier.

Any person contravening this order, is liable to be punished under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.

As the notice cannot be served individually on all concerned the order is hereby passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of public through press and by affixing copies on the notice boards of the offices of all Divisional D.Cs.P, all Divisional A.D.Cs.P, all Divisional A.Cs.P and all Police Stations concerned;

WHEREAS, from the reports received so far, there is sufficient ground to apprehend that the terrorists or anti-social elements may seek hideouts in the residential areas of the Police Stations, falling under metropolitan area of Howrah,

AND WHEREAS, there is every likelihood of breach of peace and disturbance of public tranquility and also there is grave danger to human life and safety and injury to public property on that account,

AND WHEREAS, it is felt necessary that some procedural safeguards should be put on tenancy or licensing process prevailing, so that terrorists or anti-social elements in the guise of tenants may not get tenancy or license for residential purpose and to cause disturbance or public tranquility or danger to human life or safety to public at large,

AND WHEREAS, it is felt expedient to cause immediate prevention of those apprehended danger and arrange for speedy remedy thereof, in the interest of public tranquility, safety of human life, prevention of injury, annoyance to persons etc.,

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (I) read with sub-section (3) of section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (2 of 1974), I, Praveen Kumar Tripathi, Commissioner of Police, Howrah and Executive Magistrate in relation to the Metropolitan area of Howrah and being empowered so to do by the State Government Home (Police) Department Order No. 3636-PL/PB/14M-138/04 dt. 26.08.2011 to act under Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (2 of 1974), do hereby order that no land-lord or owner or person whose property falls under the jurisdiction of area of any of the Police Stations under Howrah Metropolitan area shall let/sublet/lease/rent out any residential accommodation or grant lease or license to any person unless and until the said landlord/owner/person has furnished the particulars of the said tenant(s)/ license as the case may be as per the Proforma in Schedule-I to the Officer in-Charge of the Police Station concerned. And whoever having property in his possession or under his management shall also inform in writing to the Officer-in-Charge of the Police Station concerned in whose jurisdiction the premise falls about the particulars of the tenants or leasee or licensee as the case may be as per the said proforma.

This order shall come into force on and from 26<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2023 and remain in force for a period of 60 (sixty) days i.e., upto 24<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2024 unless rescinded or altered earlier.

Any person contravening this order is liable to be punished under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.

As the notice cannot be served individually on all concerned the order is hereby passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of public through Howrah Police Gazette, Official Website of Howrah City Police and by affixing copies on the notice boards of the offices of DCP, Central Division, DCP, South Division, DCP North Division, Divisional DCPs, Divisional ACPs and all Police Stations concerned and the Offices of Howrah Municipal Corporation.
