WHEREAS information has been received from credible sources that violent demonstrations are likely to take place resulting in large scale disturbance of the public tranquility and breach of the peace in the area mentioned in the schedule below (of the Shibpur and Chatterjeehat Police Station) in the town of Howrah (hereinafter referred to as the said areas).

And

WHEREAS I, Praveen Kumar Tripathi, Commissioner of Police, Howrah being the Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Howrah, have been specially empowered by the State Government vide Home (Police) Department Order No.- 1544-P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-29/2011 Dated 16.08.2024 to act under the Section 163 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (Act. 46 of 2023).

And

WHEREAS in my opinion, there is sufficient ground for proceeding under the said Section for immediate prevention of disturbances of the public tranquility and breach of peace within the said area in the town of Howrah.

And

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by Sub-Section (1) of section 163 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (Act. 46 of 2023) read with the sub-section (3) of the said section, I, Praveen Kumar Tripathi, Commissioner of Police, Howrah and Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Howrah, do hereby prohibit for the period of 60 (sixty) days from the 6th November, 2024 to 4th January, 2025 until further orders, any assembly of 05 (five) or more persons in procession or the carrying of any lathi or other dangerous weapons or the doing of any act which is likely to cause disturbances to the public tranquility and breach of the peace within the said area in the town of Howrah.

The area within the jurisdiction of Shibpur and Chatterjeehat Police Station in the town of Howrah bounded -

Exceptions:-

- 1) On the North by -Haradeb Bhattacharyay Road upto and including Mandirtala Bus Stand.
- 2) On the East by -Khetro Banerjee Road, Nabin Banerjee Lane, AK Roy Chowdhury Lane and Mollapara Lane upto G T Road crossing including Kazipara Morh. Hiralal Banerjee Road, Dinu Master Lane, Mollahpara Lane upto G.T. Road Crossing (D.B. College), Danesh Mollah Lane upto G T Road crossing.
- 3) On the West by -K. M. Banerjee Road, Circular 2nd Bye Lane, Seikhpara, Kona Expressway upto Carry Road crossing. K. M. Banerjee Lane, Sarat Chatterjee Road upto old 58 Bus stand.
- 4) On the South by -Tarapada Chatterjee Road, Upen Chatterjee Road upto Betaitala Morh.

➤ **Emergency vehicles like – Vehicles carrying LPG Cylinders only, Petroleum, Oil, Lubricants, Oxygen, Milk, Medicine, Vegetable / Fruits / Fish etc.**

1. Nimtala crossing towards Bally along GT Road.
2. Ballykhal Island towards Bally along GT Road.
3. Maitypara crossing towards Gurudwara / Nibedita Setu / Bally.
4. NH-19 & NH-16 crossing towards Nibedita Setu.
5. 'O' point towards Old Bally Bridge / Nibedita Setu.
6. Bamundanga Island towards Bally & Dakshineswar along GT Road & Vivekananda Setu.
7. All kinds of Goods Vehicles restriction / diversion on NS Road approaching towards Liluah Flyover from Liluah side & Bally side.
8. Near Salap Morh towards Dasnagar along Howrah - Amta Road.
9. Near Salap bazaar towards Dasnagar along Howrah - Amta Road.
10. No Entry has been imposed at Belgachia Morh on Benaras Road. Any Goods vehicles if comes from Dankuni side will be diverted again towards Dankuni from this point.
11. Kona morh on NH-16 towards Liluah along Benaras Road.
12. Kazipara crossing towards Kolkata & towards Howrah via 2nd Hooghly Bridge & GT Road.
13. Coal depot towards Howrah along Foreshore Road.
14. Tollplaza towards Kolkata via 2nd Hooghly Bridge and Kazipara.
15. Ramp of 2nd Hooghly Bridge towards Mandirtala and Kazipara.
16. Near Alampur morh towards 2nd Hooghly Bridge along Andul Road.
17. Hung-Sung crossing towards Drainage Canal Road & 2nd Hooghly Bridge.
18. Kona Truck terminal towards Kolkata & Howrah City along Kona Expressway & 2nd Hooghly Bridge.
19. Near Nibra morh towards Kolkata & Howrah City along Kona Expressway & 2nd Hooghly Bridge.
20. All kinds of Goods Vehicles will be restricted within Bally & Howrah Municipal area as per time format mentioned above.

(II) In the interest of public safety and convenience the movement of all vehicles shall be prohibited to ply within the Howrah Police Commissionerate area as follows:-

From 11:30 hrs. to 22:00 hrs. on 07.11.2024.
From 02:00 hrs. to 10:00 hrs. on 08.11.2024.

Exceptions:-

➤ **Emergency vehicles like – Vehicles carrying LPG Cylinders only, Petroleum, Oil, Lubricants, Oxygen, Milk, Medicine, Vegetable / Fruits / Fish etc.**

1. All type of vehicles entry and parking From Banstala Ghat to Rail Museum on Grand Foreshore road.
2. Goods vehicle Entry & Parking within HRS TG area during Chhat Puja.
3. No vehicle will proceed towards Rail Museum & Burn More from Station area.
4. From Fazir Bazar Crossing towards Banstala Ghat Crossing along Gangadhar Mukherjee Lane.
5. All type of vehicles entry and parking from Coal Depot to towards, Shibpur burning Ghat and river side road up to Shibpur launch Ghat road and Foreshore Road crossing.

(III) The vehicular traffic shall be diverted to ply within the Howrah Police Commissionerate area as specified below at the following roads –

From 11:30 hrs. to 22:00 hrs. on 07.11.2024.

All the ramps of Vidyasagar Setu on Howrah side.

- 5) Explanation -In this order, the Town of Howrah means the town of Howrah as defined in Section 2(15) and Schedule - I of the Howrah Municipal Corporation Act, 1980 (Act of 29 of 1980).
