Whereas for preventing danger, obstruction or inconvenience to the public in connection with observance of 'Shahid Diwas' by West Bengal Pradesh Trinamool Yuba Congress Committee in front of Head Office of CESC Ltd. i.e. Victoria House, Kolkata on 21.07.2025, it is necessary in the interest of Public safety, to impose traffic restrictions for regulating the movement of vehicles at different parts of Howrah Commissionerate area. In exercise of powers conferred upon me U/S 112(2)/115/116/117 of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 vide Notification No. 2827(A)-WT/3M-80/2002 dated 01.09.2011 of Transport Department I, Praveen Kumar Tripathi, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Howrah do hereby issue following restriction order as per following time schedule on the following roads --

Date & Time -

On 21.07.2025 from 02:00 hrs. to 20:00 hrs.

<u>Restrictions for all type of Goods Vehicles</u> (except emergency vehicles, LPG vehicles, Vegetable, Medicine, Fruits & Milk carrying vehicles)

- 1. Nimtala crossing towards Bally along GT Road.
- 2. Ballykhal Island towards Bally along GT Road.
- 3. Bamundanga Island towards Bally & Dakshineswar along GT Road & Vivekananda Setu.

- 4. NH-19 & NH-16 crossing towards Nibedita Toll.
- Near Salap More towards Dasnagar along Howrah Amta Road on Kabardanga Morh.
- Kona Morh on NH-16 towards Liluah along Benaras Road towards Jagadishpur.
- Kazipara crossing towards Kolkata & towards Howrah via 2nd Hooghly Bridge and GT Road.
- 8. Near Alampur Morh towards 2nd Hooghly Bridge along Andul Road.
- Hung Sung crossing towards Sailen Manna Sarani (Drainage Canal Road) and 2nd Hooghly Bridge.
- 10. Kona Truck Terminal towards Kolkata & Howrah City side along Kona Express way and $2^{\rm nd}$ Hooghly Bridge.
- 11. Near Nibra Morh to towards Kolkata & Howrah City along Kona Express way and 2nd Hooghly Bridge.
- 12. Howrah & GT Road bound via 2nd Hooghly Bridge & Kona Express way.

In addition to the above, no Goods Vehicles will be allowed to ply within this Commissionerate area from 02:00 hrs to 20:00 hrs. on 21.07.2025.

Restrictions for all other vehicles:

All Panchanantala bound passenger vehicles will be diverted from Sarat Statue at GR Road towards Fish Market via IC Bose Road, CM Bridge, GT Road, Phansitala, Panchanantala at Howrah.

No vehicle will be ply along M.G. Road, Church Road, Nityadhan Mukherjee Road.

Restrictions of slow moving vehicles:

Slow moving vehicles will be restricted to ply along Foreshore Road, G.T. Road, Panchantala Road, N.S. Road, Grand Foreshore Road, Girish Ghosh Road, Aravindo Road, J.N. Mukherjee Road, Andul Road, Sailen Manna Sarani (Drainage Cannel Road), East West Bye Pass Road from 9 AM to 12 PM on 21.07.2025.

Vehicles may also be diverted from any of the roads by the Traffic Police on duty as and when considered necessary.

These regulations will remain in force in addition to the other normal traffic restrictions on the day (21.07.2025), which are not repugnant to the above.

WHEREAS, from the reports received so far, there is sufficient ground to apprehend that the terrorists or anti-social elements may seek hideouts in the residential areas of the Police Stations, falling under metropolitan area of Howrah,

AND WHEREAS, there is every likelihood of breach of peace and disturbance of public tranquility and also there is grave danger to human life and safety and injury to public property on that account,

AND WHEREAS, it is felt necessary that some procedural safeguards should be put on tenancy or licensing process prevailing, so that terrorists or anti-social elements in the guise of tenants may not get tenancy or license for residential purpose and to cause disturbance or public tranquility or danger to human life or safety to public at large,

AND WHEREAS, it is felt expedient to cause immediate prevention of those apprehended danger and arrange for speedy remedy thereof, in the interest of public tranquility, safety of human life, prevention of injury, annoyance to persons etc.,

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the power conferred by sub-section (1) read with sub-section (3) of section 163 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (Act. 46 of 2023), I, Praveen Kumar Tripathi, Commissioner of Police, Howrah and Executive Magistrate in relation to the Metropolitan area of Howrah and being empowered so to do by the State Government Home (Police) Department Order No.- 1544-P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-29/2011 Dated 16.08.2024 to act under the Section 163 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (Act. 46 of 2023), do hereby order that no land-lord or owner or person whose property falls under the jurisdiction of area of any of the Police Stations under Howrah Metropolitan area shall let/sublet/lease/rent out any residential accommodation or grant lease or license to any person unless and until the said landlord/owner/person has furnished the particulars of the said tenant(s)/ license as the case may be as per the Proforma in Schedule-I to the Officer -in-Charge of the Police Station concerned. And whoever having property in his possession or under his management shall also inform in writing to the Officer-in-Charge of the Police Station concerned in whose jurisdiction the premise falls about the particulars of the tenants or leasee or licensee as the case may be as per the said proforma.

This order shall come into force on and from 18th day of July, 2025 and remain in force for a period of 60 (sixty) days i.e., upto 15th day of September, 2025 unless rescinded or altered earlier.

Any person contravening this order is liable to be punished under Section 223 of the Bharatiya Nayaya Sanhita, 2023.

As the notice cannot be served individually on all concerned the order is hereby passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of public through Howrah Police Gazette, Official Website of Howrah City Police and by affixing copies on the notice boards of the offices of DCP, Central Division, DCP, South Division, DCP North Division, Divisional ADCsP, Divisional ACSP and all Police Stations concerned and the Offices of Howrah Municipal Corporation.

WHEREAS, a large number of commercial places, network service providers and shops have come up in the Metropolitan area of Howrah as notified in this behalf, in the popular name Cyber Cafe,

AND WHEREAS, a large number of people frequently visit these Cafes to use the internet, computer network facilities available in those cyber cafes,

AND WHEREAS, there is every likelihood that the said facilities might be used by persons knowingly or intentionally to mislead the security and investigating agencies, commit offence as defined in Chapter-XI of the Information Technology Act, 2000 (21 of 2000), create panic in the public, help in anti-national activities affecting security of the state.

AND WHEREAS, it is felt expedient to cause immediate prevention of those apprehended danger and arrange for speedy remedy thereof, in the interest of public tranquility, safety of human life, prevention of injury, annoyance to persons etc.,

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the power conferred by subsection (1) read with sub-section (3) of section 163 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (Act. 46 of 2023), I, Praveen Kumar Tripathi, Commissioner of Police, Howrah and Executive Magistrate in relation to the Metropolitan area of Howrah and being empowered so to do by the State Government Home (Police) Department Order No.-1544-P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-29/2011 Dated 16.08.2024 to act under the Section 163 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (Act. 46 of 2023), do hereby order, the owners of the said cyber cafes and persons having management of those cyber cafes to follow the followings in respect of those cyber cafes, viz.:-

- a) Prohibiting the use of cyber cafe by unknown person and whose identity has not been established before the owner of the cafe.
- b) Maintaining a register for identity of the visitors or users.
- c) Make an entry in the handwriting of the visitors or users maintaining name, address, telephone number and identity proof. The visitors/users shall also sign the register kept for this purpose.
- d) The identity of the visitors or users shall be established through Identity Card, Voter Card, Ration Card, Driving License, Passport and Photo Credit Card (any one of them).
- e) Activity server log should be preserved in main server and its record should be preserved for at least six months from the point of last use.

- f) If any activity of any visitors or users is of a suspicious nature, the owner of Cyber Cafe shall immediately inform the nearest Police Station.
- Record be maintained about the specific computer used by the visitor or user.

This order shall come into force on and from 18th day of July, 2025 and remain in force for a period of 60 (sixty) days i.e., upto 15th day of September, 2025 unless rescinded or altered earlier.

Any person contravening this order, is liable to be punished under Section 223 of the Bharatiya Nayaya Sanhita, 2023.

As the notice cannot be served individually on all concerned the order is hereby passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of public through press and by affixing copies on the notice boards of the offices of all Divisional DCsP, all Divisional ACsP and all Police Stations concerned;

Whereas, as informed by Sr. Div. Engineer (Co-ondn) Eastern Railway, Howrah vide No.52W/1/3 date. 15.07.2025,the load carrying capacity of Benaras ROB (Bamangachi) on Banaras Road has been reduced and it cannot withstand the load of heavy vehicles and it is necessary in the interest of Public safety and also to prevent danger, obstruction, inconvenience to Public in general, to impose traffic restrictions for regulating the movement of vehicles at different parts of Howrah Commissionerate till the ROB is repaired / till construction of new ROB is completed, I, Praveen Kumar Tripathi, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Howrah, in exercise of power conferred upon me u/s 112(2)/115/116/117 of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 vide Notification no. 2827(A)-WT/3M-80/2002 dated 01.09.2011 of Transport Department, Govt. of West Bengal, the following restriction order, on the following stretch of road and time as mentioned hereunder,

Restriction Period & Type of Restriction:

24- hours every day for until further order

i) No entry of heavy goods vehicles on & above 05 (five) Ton, Buses and Minibuses on Benaras Road Over Bridge (Bamangachi), on Benarash Road, Howrah24- hours every day.

- ii) No entry of goods vehicles on & above 05 (five) Ton, Buses and Minibuses from Kona More towards Salkia through Benaras Road 24- hours every day.
- iii) No entry of goods vehicles on & above 05 (five) Ton, Buses and Minibuses from Salkia towards Kona More through Benaras Road 24- hours every day.
- iv) All Salkia bound heavy goods vehicles having excess height (3.30 mtrs above) may avail NH-16 Zero point Bamundanga (Rajchandrapur) island Bally Halt Nimtala GT Road Belur Bazar GT Road Girish Ghosh Road between 10:00 PM to 06:00 AM only.
- v) All Salkia bound goods vehicles with height less than 3.30 mtrs may be diverted through Belgachia Morh> Natabar Pal Road > Chatterjeepara Morh> Sailen Manna Street (East West Bypass) > Phansitala> C M Bridge between 10:00 PM to 06:00 AM only.
- vi) All Heavy goods vehicles on & above 05 (five) Ton towards Benaras Road Over Bridge on Benarash Road, Howrah will be divert from Salkia crossing towards Bally / Howrah via G.T Road, A Road and Benaras Road crossing towards Belgachia, Belgachia crossing towards Kona crossing via Benarash Road, Belgahcia crossing towards Chatterjeepara crossing via Natabar Pal Road between 10:00 PM to 06:00 AM only.
- vii) All Heavy goods vehicles and Buses/mini buses coming from Liluah PS side / Liluah Bhagar side towards Banaras Road will avail Liluah Flyover G.T Road between 10:00 PM to 06:00 AM only.
- viii) All Buses/mini buses coming from Liluah PS side / LiluahBhagar side towards Banaras Road will avail Liluah Flyover G.T Road24- hours every day.
- ix) All buses and mini buses towards Salkia from Kona More will be diverted through Belgachia Morh>Natabar Pal Road >Chatterjeepara Morh>Sailen Manna Street (East West Bypass) >Phansitala> C M Bridge and vice versa 24-hours every day.

Vehicles may also be diverted from any other roads by the Traffic Police on duty as and when considered necessary.
