On 02.08.2025 & 03.08.2025 and again 09.08.2025 & 10.08.2025 huge number of pilgrims including female devotees will collect Holy water from the River Gangas throughout the Howrah Police Commissionerate area on foot and reach Tarakeswar, it is necessary in the interest of Public safety and also to prevent danger, obstruction, inconvenience to Public in general during the Procession, to impose traffic restrictions for regulating the movement of vehicles at different parts of Howrah Commissionerate during the period. Whereas for preventing danger, obstruction or inconvenience to the public in connection with NABANNA ABHIYAN being organized by Paschim Banga Chatra Samaj on 09.08.2025, it is necessary in the interest of Public safety, to impose traffic restrictions for regulating the movement of vehicles at different parts of Howrah Commissionerate area.
