Subject: Empowerment of the Offices of Divisional Deputy Commissioners of Police

It has been observed that the Offices of Divisional Deputy Commissioners of Police under HPC, often face lack of resources and witness less supervision at the junior levels. They possess limited powers with respect to transfer/posting of the officers/force and also in mobilising vehicles/reserve force etc in comparison to their counterparts in Kolkata Police.

The Kolkata Police model has demonstrated enhanced efficiency and accountability through delegated powers to Divisional DCPs. To strengthen policing at the grassroots level in Howrah, it is proposed to extend similar core powers, along with dedicated sub-units and staff.

This initiative seeks to streamline the management of personnel, and resources while improving crime detection, investigation, and law enforcement at the divisional level. Additionally, it focuses on establishing specialized wings to address modern challenges such as cybercrime, narcotics, and the welfare of police personnel, ensuring a robust and responsive framework for public safety and administrative effectiveness.

The Reserve Section is tasked with managing critical personnel functions, including leave, transfers, deployment, and training of police personnel, ensuring optimal human resource allocation and readiness. The Law Section handles court-related matters, writs, and coordination with prosecution authorities to ensure smooth legal processes. The Welfare Section focuses on the well-being of personnel, and other welfare measures to support the workforce. The Licensing Section manages licenses and permissions for processions and events, ensuring regulatory compliance and public safety.

The Crime Section maintains crime records, handles special report (SR) cases, and provides investigation support to enhance the division's ability to address criminal activities effectively. The Sub-Detective Department, including the Divisional Special Operations Group (SOG) and special squads, focuses on combating narcotics and other specialized operational challenges. The Cyber Crime Cell is dedicated to addressing cybercrime and conducting digital forensics, equipping the division to tackle the growing threat of technology-related offences.

In view of the above restructuring proposal to empower Divisional Deputy Commissioners of Police, the following subunits are created at the Offices of Divisional Deputy Commissioners of Police in the interest of public service and administrative convenience. Details are as follows:-
