WHEREAS, it is further felt expedient to arrange for speedy remedy in case of breach of peace and public tranquility on the aforesaid day in and around the examination centres,

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the power conferred by Sub-Section (1) of section 163 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (Act. 46 of 2023) read with the sub-section (3) of the said section, I, Praveen Kumar Tripathi, Commissioner of Police, Howrah and Executive Magistrate in relation to the Metropolitan area of Howrah and being empowered so to do by the State Government vide Home (Police) Department Order No. -1544-P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-29/2011 Dated 16.08.2024 to act under the Section 163 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (Act. 46 of 2023) do hereby prohibit the assembly of five (5) or more persons within the radius of 100 (hundred) meters of the periphery of the mentioned examination centres within the Metropolitan area of Howrah on 18.10.2025 from 07:00 hrs. to 14:00 hrs. for JELET-2025 & from 07:00 hrs. to 16:30 hrs. for JENPAS (UG)-2025 and on 19.10.2025 from 07:00 hrs. to 14:30 hrs. for ANM & GNM-2025 & JECA-2025, as mentioned above.

And all the Photo Cyber Café/Photo Copy/Printing Shops operating within 100 meters from the above examination centres shall not be allowed to operate on 18.10.2025 from 07:00 hrs. to 14:00 hrs. for JELET-2025 & from 07:00 hrs. to 16:30 hrs. for JENPAS (UG)-2025 and on 19.10.2025 from 07:00 hrs. to 14:30 hrs. for ANM & GNM-2025 & JECA-2025, as mentioned above.

Whereas it is necessary preventing danger, obstruction or inconvenience to the public to regulate traffic of all kinds during the **Kali Puja festival on 20.10.2025** and during **Kali Puja immersion days on 21.10.2025, 22.10.2025** and **23.10.2025**. I, Praveen Kumar Tripathi, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Howrah in exercise of the powers conferred upon me U/112(2)/115/116/117 of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 vide Notification No 2827(A)-WT/3M-80/2002 dated 01.09.2011 of Transport Department do hereby issue the following restriction orders as per following time schedule on the following roads –

(I) In the interest of public safety and convenience the movement of Goods Vehicles shall be prohibited to ply towards Kolkata as well as within Howrah City as per the following schedule on the following roads –

WHEREAS information has been received from credible sources that violent demonstrations are likely to take place resulting in large scale disturbance of the public tranquility and breach of the peace in the area mentioned in the schedule below (of the Shibpur and Chatterjeehat Police Station) in the town of Howrah (hereinafter referred to as the said areas).

And

WHEREAS I, Praveen Kumar Tripathi, Commissioner of Police, Howrah being the Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Howrah, have been specially empowered by the State Government vide Home (Police) Department Order No.- 1544-P.S. Cell/HR/O/3P-29/2011 Dated 16.08.2024 to act under the Section 163 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (Act. 46 of 2023).

And

WHEREAS in my opinion, there is sufficient ground for proceeding under the said Section for immediate prevention of disturbances of the public tranquility and breach of peace within the said area in the town of Howrah.

And

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred by Sub-Section (1) of section 163 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (Act. 46 of 2023) read with the sub-section (3) of the said section, I, Praveen Kumar Tripathi, Commissioner of Police, Howrah and Executive Magistrate for the Metropolitan area of Howrah, do hereby prohibit for the period of 60 (sixty) days from the 1st November, 2025 to 30th December, 2025 until further orders, any assembly of 05 (five) or more persons in procession or the carrying of any lathi or other dangerous weapons or the doing of any act which is likely to cause disturbances to the public tranquility and breach of the peace within the said area in the town of Howrah.
